Wonder by R.J. Palacio the fiction book for students to read this summer. It will tie in with the first book we read together as a class first quarter.

After reading the book, give a brief report that follows these guidelines:

Give the author, title, and genre of the book. Briefly describe the main character(s), setting, plot, conflict and resolution. Rate the book you read on a scale of 1-5, with 5 being the highest/best rating. Finally, give a recommendation for the book. Would you suggest that others read this book? Why or why not?

The non-fiction book to read is: Who Was Anne Frank?

For each non-fiction book write a summary answering who the person was, when did they live, where did they live, why do we remember them? What were their accomplishments?

Turn your summer reading assignment in to Ms. Crosby by August 16th. Make certain that you have your name on it. Students will also take AR tests for the books when they return to school. You will receive a grade in reading class for the entire assignment.

**Students must have their own copy of the book *Ugly* by Robert Hoge for the start of school as well as *Escape From Saigon* by Andrea Warren. Once again, these two books are to be read in class, not over the summer.
