

Incoming 6th grade Summer Reading Assignment

***Wonder* by R.J. Palacio is the fiction book for students to read this summer.** It will tie in with the first book we read together as a class.

After reading the book, give a brief report that follows these guidelines:

Give the author, title, and genre of the book. Briefly describe the main character(s), setting, plot, conflict, and resolution. Rate the book you read on a scale of 1-5, with 5 being the highest/best rating. Finally, give a recommendation for the book. Would you suggest that others read this book? Why or why not?

The non-fiction book to read is *Who was Anne Frank* by Anne Abramson.

For the non-fiction book write a summary answering who the person was, when did they live (if they have died); where do/did they live; why do we remember them; what were their accomplishments?

Turn your summer reading assignment in to Ms. Crosby by August 14th. Make certain you have your name on it. Students may also take AR tests for the books when they return to school, but remember that the longer it is between finishing the book and taking the AR test, the lower your grade may be. **You will receive a grade in reading class for the entire assignment.**

****Students must have their own copy of the book *Escape From Saigon* by Andrea Warren for the start of school. We will be reading this book together in class.**
